



# **Thursday Morning Bible Study**



### What are we Learning this Month?

Our theme will be animals this month. We will talk about different types of animals and where they live. We will also be talking about Noah's Ark.

Blue Class (Mrs. Baker) – For handwriting, we will work on Aa, Vv and Gg. We will continue to work on counting and identifying those tricky teen numbers. Some of my students are still working on identifying letters and sounds while other students will be working on simple sight words (such as see, like, the) and CVC words (such as dog, cat, sun). We will also begin practicing their address and phone number.

**Red Class (Mrs. Fathman)** – We will learn about the letters Gg, Aa, and Vv and number recognition. We will continue to practice patterns.

**Yellow Class (Mrs. Bohne)** – We will explore the letters G, A and V. We will continue working on shapes and number recognition 1-10.


We will have our first fundraiser of the year on March 8th with a pork chop lunch after church! A big Thank You to Tommy Licata for helping us!


