This will be the first time since its conception in 1951 that there has not been a Country Christmas event led by the church women. Without our major fundraisers, Country Christmas and Rummage Sale, we will unfortunately lose the ability to support our mission outreach as planned this year. With a lot of prayer, we will look forward to the time when we can get back to doing what we do best...continuing traditions that offer fellowship and that help our budget so we can help those in need.

Mission Support:

The church investments have done extremely well since the first of the year. As a result, the Session has approved \$5,000 to be set aside for support of local missions. On an immediate basis, \$1,000 will be given to RAMM and \$500 will be given to Haven House.

The rest of the money will be available for other mission work as the need becomes clear.

Stewardship 2021:

It is time to think about the Stewardship Campaign for 2021. Because of the coronavirus pandemic, we will not do our traditional route books this year. Instead we will utilize pledge letters requesting your Financial and Time & Talent pledge for 2021. Look for letter in the mail in mid-October.



<u>RAMM</u>




September Preschool News
