

Thursday Morning Bible Study


Thursday Morning Bible Study will stop until further notice due to COVID.

What are we Learning this Month?

Our theme will be Construction this month. Our Bible story will be the Story of Creation.

Blue Class (Mrs. Baker) – For handwriting, we will work on Aa, Vv and Gg. We will continue to work on counting and identifying those tricky teen numbers. Some of my students are still working on identifying letters and sounds while other students will be working on simple CVC words (such as dog, cat, sun).

Red Class (Mrs. Fathman) – We will learn about the letters Gg, Aa, and Vv and review the numbers 14, 15, 16. We will work on the colors pink and purple, the heart shape, rhyming and continue to practice patterns.

Yellow Class (Mrs. Bohne) – We will explore the letters G, A and V. We will continue working on number recognition 1-10. We will talk about the heart shape, and review the other shapes we have learned. We will also talk about how to be a good friend.

We will be having our Valentine's Day parties at the preschool on February 11 and 12!
